## For Your Online Application (Before Your Audition)

Upload 3 of your best digital artworks that you have created yourself for your online application. They can be digital paintings, digital illustrations, graphic design work, photographs etc. If you choose to submit a portrait, please do not submit portraits of young people, but only adults who have consented to having their photos taken. Otherwise, photos of objects, places, landscapes, animals, cities, etc. Use JPGs or PNGs only for your upload. Vertical or horizontal submissions are acceptable. Please ensure all content is appropriate for a school setting.

## **During Your Audition**

**Prior to Your Audition:** Make sure you have a student/school log-in for <u>Canva</u>. Familiarize yourself with the different functions and areas of Canva, as you will be creating a brief landscape video on Canva using a supplied bank of photos, images, and other materials. Students will be asked to log in to a Mac in our school's Mac Lab. If a student is a DCDSB student, please ensure you know your computer log in. Students who come from outside of the DCDSB will be provided with a computer log-in.

**During Your Audition**: You will also have an interview with the admissions panel. We will ask you to expand upon the experiences, interests, and information you provided in your application package. You will also speak to the **three pieces of digital artwork** you submitted on your application. The images will be found on your application, but you're welcome to bring in hard copies if you like.

While waiting for your interview, students will be instructed to create a brief, artistic video based on a series of principles taught at the start of the audition task. All students will be provided with the same bank of images and music and will be provided with a general artistic framework from which to create their video. Students will have approximately 60 minutes to create their video and share it in Canva (via email) with the instructor(s) to review.
