How to Prepare for a Dance Audition

- Start preparing early, and work on creating a piece of choreography that showcases your passion for dance and performance capabilities
- Record yourself so you can watch yourself, and have someone else watch you and offer feedback.
- Practice a mock interview with questions you think could be asked during the interview and think about how you would answer them (most questions will ask you to expand on responses from your application)

Dance Audition Specifics

- Dance applicants should wear all black dance attire.
- Hair should be pulled back and out of the face
- Footwear is optional and up to the dancer.
- The solo audition piece should NOT include the use of props.
- The music selection must be clean in terms of language and choreography appropriate for a school environment.
