

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE – 216-4

Opening or Closing Exercises

Area: Governance

Policy Reference: Equity and Inclusive Education (PO216)

1. Purpose

The purpose of this procedure in schools is to provide a structured and consistent approach to starting and ending the school day. These exercises typically include activities such as the Land Acknowledgement, the singing of the national anthem, prayers, scripture readings, or other reflective practices.

3. Procedures

- 3.1 Every Elementary and Secondary school under the Board's jurisdiction shall include a period of time designated for opening or closing exercises within the daily schedule.
- 3.2 Opening or closing exercises shall include the Land Acknowledgement, singing of O Canada, and Prayer (Appendix A English/French).
- 3.3 The principal is responsible for considering the inclusion of the Oath of Citizenship and Pledge to the Canadian Flag (Appendix A English/French) in consultation with the Catholic School Council at the beginning of each school year.
- 3.4 Principals shall review the procedures and expectations for Opening or Closing exercises with staff.
- 3.5 Parents/guardians/caregivers or adult students may request exemptions from specific components of the Opening or Closing exercises by submitting a written request to the principal.

3.6 The principal must review and approve exemption requests in accordance with Board policy.

Pledge of Citizenship / Canadian Oath of Citizenship

English
