PARENT/GUARDIAN RESULTS

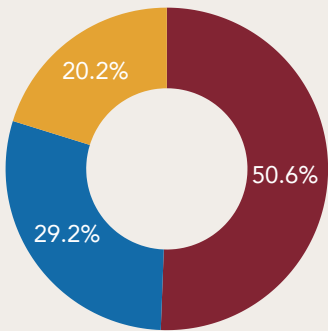
Every two years, the Durham Catholic District School Board (DCDSB) conducts the School Climate Survey as part of our commitment to creating and maintaining safe, inclusive, and welcoming schools. The survey is a requirement of the Ministry of Education as part of the Safe and Accepting Schools initiative.

In keeping with our goals to improve student learning, advance human rights and equity, and support faith and well-being, the DCDSB administered a School Climate Survey in November 2024, to collect input from students, parents/guardians and staff to measure their perceptions of safety in our schools.

Parents/Guardians of Grade 4-12 students completed the survey. See below for result highlights.

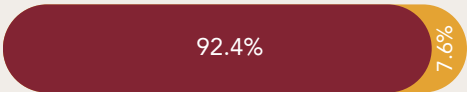
Are you satisfied with the steps your school has taken to prevent bullying and/or harassment among students?



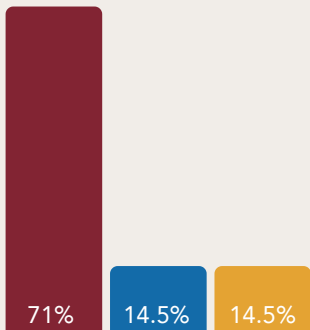

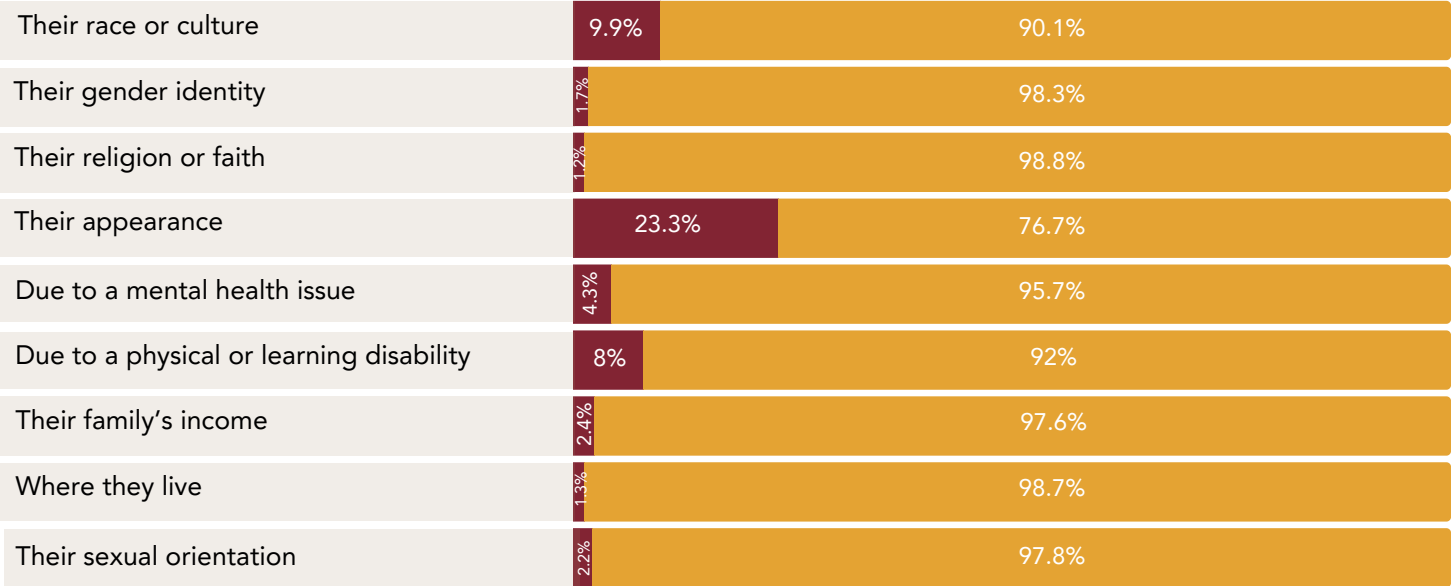


Student well-being is important to staff at my child’s school:

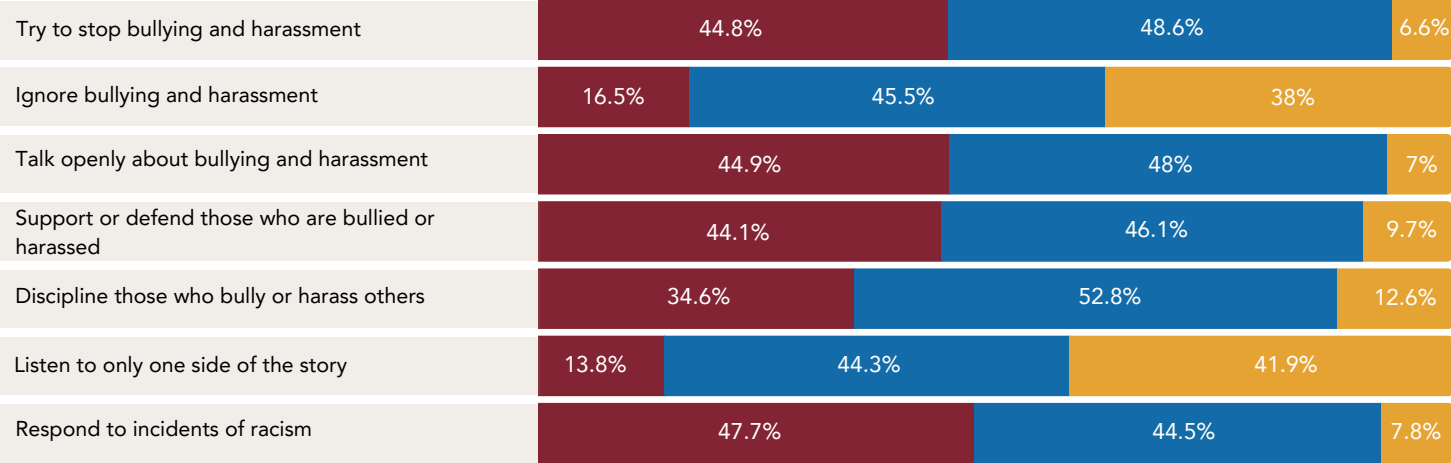

Since September, has your child has been bullied or harassed for any of the following reasons? Yes No

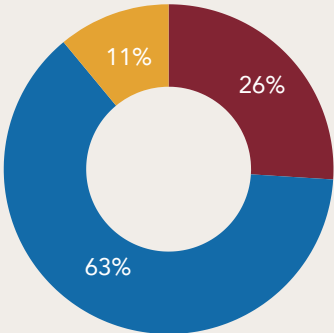


How often do you think adults in your child's school... Often Sometimes Never
