1. Introduction

It is the policy of the Durham Catholic District School Board to comply with the *Fair Dealing Guidelines* as developed by the Council of Ministers of Education Canada (CMEC) Copyright Consortium. The Durham Catholic District School Board will communicate the *Fair Dealing Guidelines* to all school locations on an annual basis in order to ensure that all staff understand the obligations of the school Board in accordance with the *Copyright Modernization Act*.

2. Definitions

Fair Dealing – identifies allowable purposes (or dealings) for the use of copyright protected materials without permission or payment of copyright royalties. Two criteria must be met in order to qualify for "fair dealing". Copying must be for a purpose stated in the Copyright Act. With the passage of the Copyright Modernization Act, "education" is now an allowable purpose.

Copying must be "fair". In its July 2012 decision, the Supreme Court supported the position that it is "fair" for a teacher to copy "short excerpts" from copyright protected material for students in a class.

3. Purpose

The purpose of this policy is twofold; first, to ensure compliance with the *Copyright Modernization Act* and; second, to establish a policy and related administrative procedure framework for all staff in meeting their obligations for compliance.

4. Application / Scope

This policy and related administrative procedure applies to all users of copyrighted materials in the Board, including staff, and Trustees.

5. Principles

The Board recognizes the Fair Dealing Guidelines of the Copyright Modernization Act as the established parameters for the use of copyrighted materials in the Board. The Board accepts its responsibility to ensure compliance with the Fair Dealing Guidelines developed from the Copyright Modernization Act. The Board understands its obligation to inform all staff of the requirements of the Fair Dealing Guidelines.

6. Requirements

- 6.1 The Director of Education or designate shall develop a related Copyright administrative procedure which incorporates the *Fair Dealing Guidelines*.
- The Director of Education or designate shall ensure that all staff are informed, on an annual basis, of the Copyright policy and Copyright administrative procedure.
