



## **ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE – AP102-9**

### **Contract Extension Process**

Area: Business and Finance  
Policy Reference: Purchasing of Goods and Services (PO102)

#### **1. Purpose**

This process applies to existing contracts that are a result of a Procurement Procedure administered by or through Purchasing Services.

#### **2. Definitions**

#### **3. Procedures**

3.1 Contract extensions can be made in the following instances:

3.1.1 Existing Contract Renewal Option: Extensions can only be executed where the original contract has specified extension terms and those terms must be upheld at the sole discretion of the Board.

3.1.2 Extraordinary Circumstances: Contracts may be extended beyond their original term under extraordinary circumstances, subject to:

- a) Recommendation from the requisitioning Superintendent or Member of Senior Administration
- b) Consultation with the Supervisor of Purchasing Services
- c) Completion and authorization as outlined on the Rationale for Non-Competitive Procurement Form

Examples may include insolvency or other circumstances that prevent the new contract from becoming effective. Extensions should be short-term.

### 3.1.3 Emergency

- a) Situations posing potential safety risks to staff or students may warrant an immediate extension of the contract.
- b) Extensions should be limited to the shortest term necessary to resolve the emergency, unless it is determined there is a high risk of recurrence. In such cases, the contract may be extended to allow time for proper procurement.
- c) Completion and authorization as outlined on the Rationale for Non-Competitive Procurement Form.
- d) The completion of the Rationale for Non-Competitive Procurement Form will be required.
