Regional Arts & Media Program Instrumental Music Audition

Please note that all Regional Arts & Media Program auditions are currently scheduled to take place in person at All Saints Catholic Secondary School on January 10 and 11, 2026, with an additional day scheduled for January 17, 2026 if required. **We cannot accept any scheduling requests** due to the volume of applicants we receive.

- 1. Please register/apply online.
- 2. Students will prepare and perform 1-2 contrasting musical selections on an instrument of their choice. You may use sheet music in your performance. We may have you perform one or both pieces
- 3. Students with limited or no instrumental music experience, who will not be performing, will be assessed based on their interview as well as the rhythm clapback test.
- 4. Students who do not perform will be assessed based on their interview as well as series of rhythm clapback tests.
- 5. here will be a short interview with 3-4 questions. Students may complete the interview before or after their performance.

Please note that in the Instrumental Music program, students may learn: flute; clarinet; trumpet; alto, tenor and baritone saxophone; trombone; baritone horn; tuba; bass guitar; ukulele; drum kit/percussion. Acoustic guitar will also be added as you progress through the program. Interested students are free to audition on any instrument they wish (such as piano, or any instrument not mentioned above). Prior experience on a musical instrument is not mandatory in order to apply. If a student has minimal or no instrumental experience, they will be considered based on their interview and rhythm test. Students may be asked to abbreviate or stop playing early to facilitate time constraints.
