Every two years, the Durham Catholic District School Board (DCDSB) conducts the School Climate Survey as part of our commitment to creating and maintaining safe, inclusive, and welcoming schools. The survey is a requirement of the Ministry of Education as part of the Safe and Accepting Schools initiative.

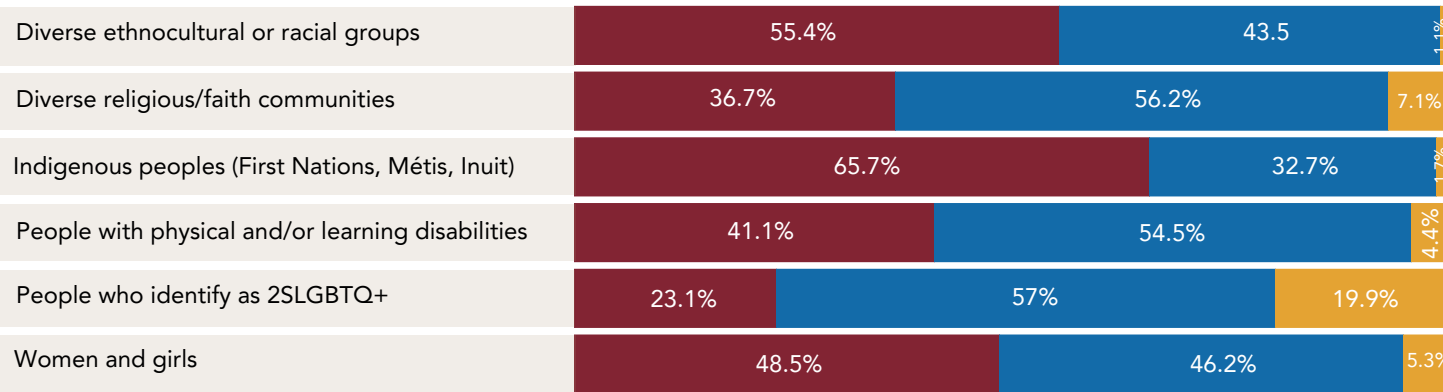

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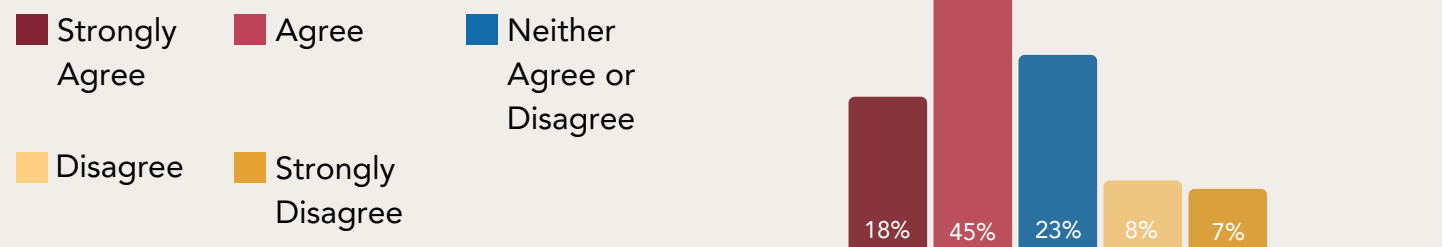

In your school, students have resources and opportunities to learn about the experiences and/or achievements of:

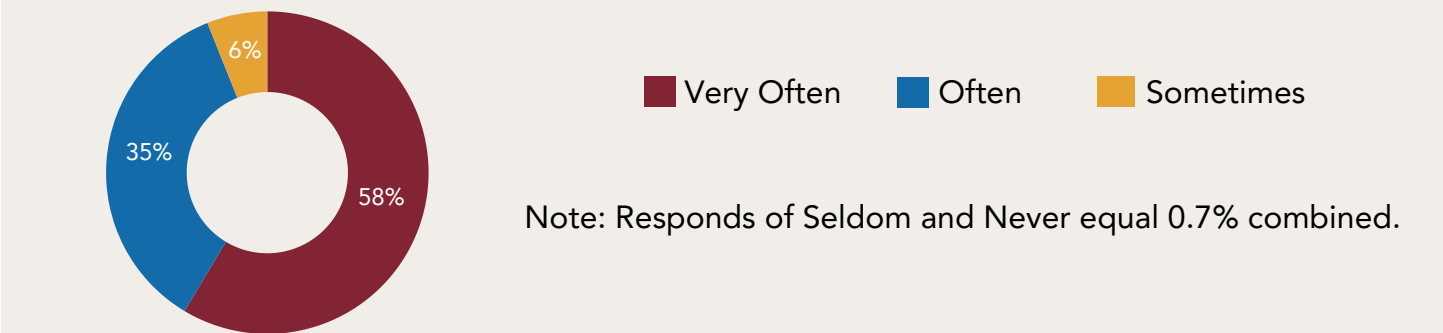

My school responds effectively to reports of bullying and harassment:

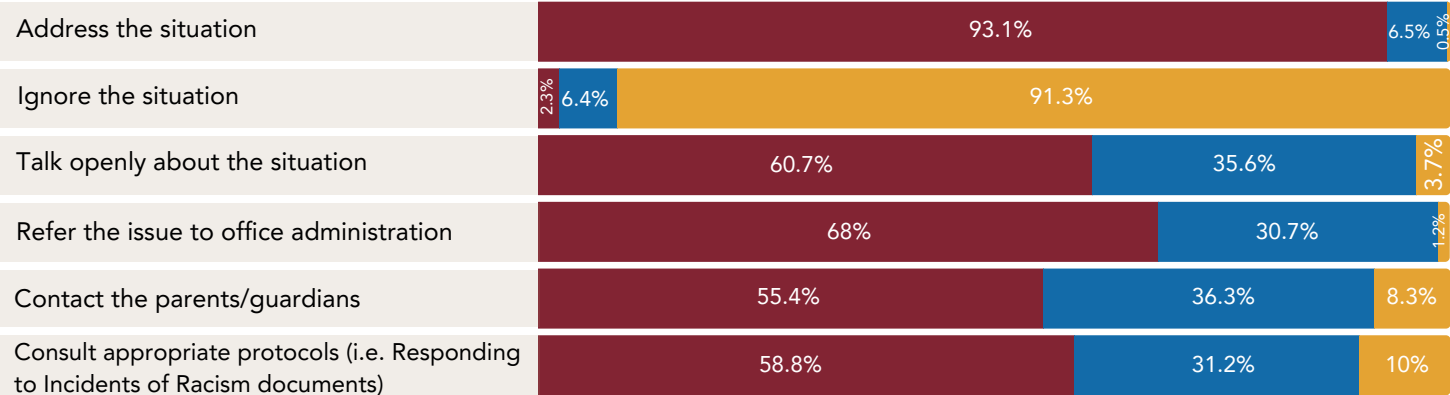


Our staff consider student well-being to be a priority:



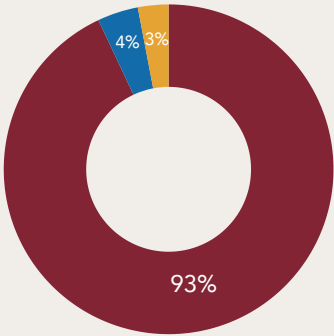
When I am aware of bullying/harassment/ incidents of racism, I...

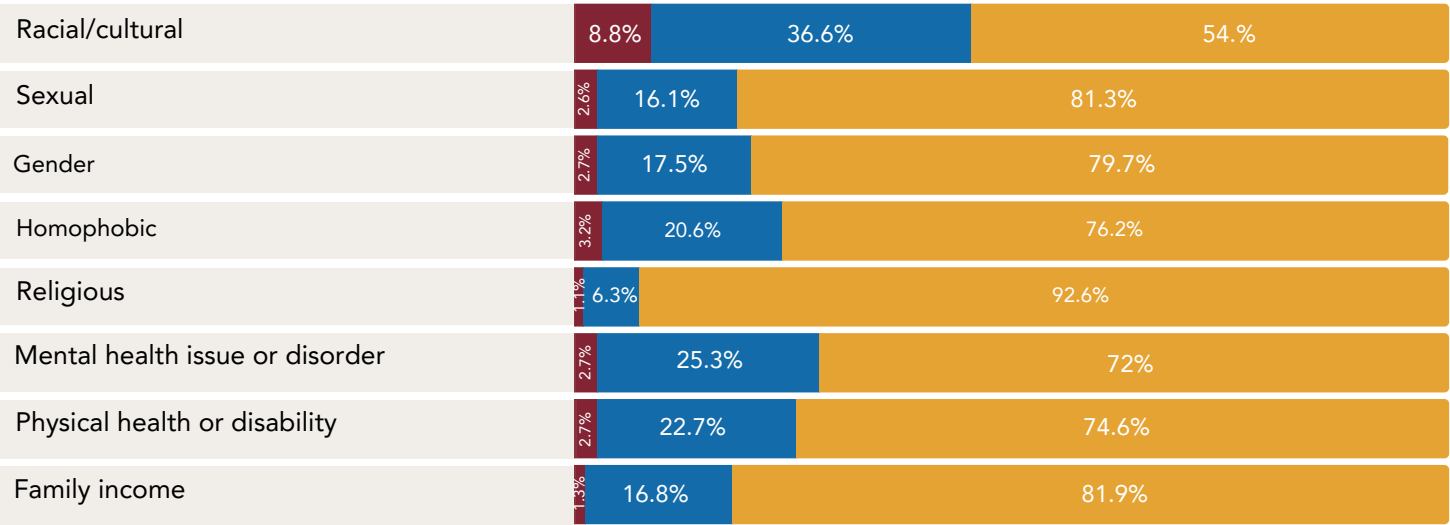
Are you familiar with the Safe Schools Incident Reporting Tool?
